

**SPINK COUNTY COMMISSION PROCEEDINGS  
REDFIELD, SOUTH DAKOTA**

The Spink County Board of Commissioners met at 8:30 AM on Thursday, November 5, 2020, at the Spink County Courthouse. Chairman Dave Albrecht called the meeting to order. Roll call of Commissioners present: Dave Albrecht, Brian Johnson, Brett Knox, Dustin Rische, and Suzanne Smith.

**ADOPT AGENDA**

Motion was made by Smith, seconded by Knox, to adopt the agenda with the addition of discussion on the law enforcement contract. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

**MINUTES APPROVED**

Motion was made by Smith, seconded by Johnson, to approve the minutes of the October 20, 2020, Commission meeting. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

No one was present for comments.

**DIRECTOR OF EQUALIZATION**

The Commission discussed the starting pay for the open Director of Equalization position.

**CARES ACT**

Theresa Hodges, Auditor, reviewed the timeline for submitting for the funding.

**COURTHOUSE CHRISTMAS TREES**

The consensus of the Commission was to suspend soliciting businesses and organizations to put up Christmas trees in the courthouse this year.

**SHERIFF**

Frank Krumm, Sheriff, gave an update of activities, filed an employee resignation letter, and requested approval to apply for a grant.

**PERSONNEL**

Motion was made by Smith, seconded by Knox, to accept the resignation of Brandon Wiest, Deputy Sheriff, effective 11/6/2020, and to approve advertising for the open position. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

**GRANT APPLICATION**

Motion was made by Johnson, seconded by Knox, to approve the Sheriff's Departments applying grant funding through the 2021 SD 24/7 Sobriety Program Staffing Grant. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT CONTRACT**

The latest correspondence from the Redfield City attorney was discussed. The County will draft a contract for the City of Redfield to take action on.

**CANVASS OF GENERAL ELECTION**

The Board canvassed the election results of the General Election held November 3, 2020. The board signed the certificate stating that the results were a true abstract of the votes cast in the jurisdiction of Spink County, South Dakota.

**FIRST READING OF REZONING**

At 9:45 AM time given by public notice, the first reading of the rezoning change for: Applicant: Ryan Palmer; Legal: Snyder's Part of OL 22 Lots 8 & 9 Mellette City, Spink County, SD; Reason for Petition to Rezone: Reclassify from Residential to Commercial, was conducted. The applicant was present for the hearing, no other person or their representative appeared for or against the change. The second reading and adoption will be held on November 17, 2019 at 9:45 AM.

**PLANNING & ZONING**

At 9:55 AM a motion was made by Smith, seconded by Knox, to recess as a Board of Commissioners and convene as a County Planning and Zoning Board. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

The Board of County Commissioners reconvened at 10:50 AM after having adjourned as the Planning and Zoning Board.

**HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT**

Jeff Haessig, Highway Superintendent, gave an update of activities, filed an employee resignation letter, and filed paperwork on the approval by SDDOT of the 5-year plan.

**PERSONNEL**

Motion was made by Knox, seconded by Johnson, to accept the resignation of Dennis Baird, Equipment Operator, effective 1/7/2021, and to approve advertising for the open position. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

**TREASURER/QUOTE**

Theresa Hodges, Auditor, filed a quote for a computer workstation in the Treasurer’s Office. Motion was made by Rische, seconded by Smith, to approve the purchase of a computer for the Treasurer’s Office, off of Connecting Point’s, Watertown, SD, quote of \$1,878.50 for an HP Prodesk 600, with Microsoft Office Home 2019 license, and onsite setup. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

**RECESS/RECONVENE**

The Board of Commissioners recessed at 11:20 AM. The Board of Commissioner reconvened at 12:50 PM to conduct interviews.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION**

At 1:00 PM a motion was made by Smith, seconded by Knox, to enter into executive session to conduct personnel interviews for the Director of Equalization. All members voted aye. Motion carried. Chairman Dave Albrecht declared the Board out of executive session at 1:56 PM.
